Project Summary

Project Overview

To enhance the scope and detail of UN system-wide financial statistics issued by CEB. To develop a comprehensive UN system-wide financial database while integrating existing databases, eliminating data collection overlaps and meeting mandated UN system-wide financial reporting requirements.

Expected Benefits:

- Availability and one-place access to comprehensive, reliable, manageable and ready-touse financial information on the entire UN system.
- Promotion and facilitation of the work of interagency and coordination bodies.
- Improved and correct visibility of assessed, voluntary and earned revenues, including those from non-state donors, with particular reference to the provisions contained in the FAFA Agreement concerning the European Commission's contributions.
- Elimination of the existing UN system-wide data collection overlaps. All financial reporting requirements will be consolidated to ensure that a complete data set is collected at one central and comprehensive repository.

Project Activities

- Analysis of stakeholder requirements, priority targets, project scope, approach and adopted standards. Review of the UN system wide financial reporting mandates and requirements of various UN system entities.
- Introduction of report types, based on priorities identified during the first activity. Adoption of common data exchange standards. Identification of counterparts in each agency.
- Launch of the public web-based domain for data capture and sharing.

Project Status

- Project is on-time for full completion by 30 November 2012
- Project is under-Budget as of 31 October 2011
- Project is forecast to remain under-Budget, even with foreign exchange costs

Main achievements Q1-Q4 2010:

- Collaboration started with UNDESA "Comprehensive statistical analysis" team, which holds a mandate to produce annual "Comprehensive statistical analysis of the financing of operational activities for development of the United Nations system".
- Information exchange initiated with the ICT Network at its meeting on 24 March 2010.
- June-September 2010: Collection and publication (A/65/187) of the UN System-wide Financial Statistics 2008-2009.
- Recruitment of a Senior Finance Project Manager.

Main achievements Q1-Q3 2011:

- January 2011 High-level "Experts" meeting held with major UN agencies, CEB, DESA and OECD.
- February May 2011 System-wide consultation.
- June 2011 Data Model proposed and circulated to UN organizations.
- August 2011 Steering Committee established (UN, WHO, WFP, UNDP, CEB).
- September 2011 FB Network endorses the Data Model.
- September 2011 IT platform chosen following consultations with IT Network members. Database to be hosted in ITU SAP Business Warehouse.

- December 2011 final sign-off by all UN organizations
- January 2012 Systems design for database and reporting solution begins
- March 2012 Systems ready for "test"

Project Activities to be undertaken in the period 1 July 2012 – 30 November 2012

Post Implementation follow-up

- It is expected that about 2/3 of all UN organizations will be able to transfer their financial data automatically to the new CEB Database system.
- During post-implementation follow-up, the Project team will work with remaining organizations with the goal of complete automation of data transfer by the end of FY 2012.
