

1995/322. Arrangements governing the framework for cooperation between the United Nations and the World Trade Organization and regarding the status of the International Trade Centre

At its 60th plenary meeting, on 12 December 1995, the Economic and Social Council (*a*) took note with satisfaction of the letter dated 24 October 1995 from the Secretary-General to the President of the Council,⁹⁶ enclosing copies of the letters exchanged by the Director-General of the World Trade Organization and the Secretary-General of the United Nations setting out a framework for cooperation between the United Nations and the World Trade Organization; (*b*) noted the recommendation in the letters exchanged that present arrangements governing the status of the International Trade Centre as a joint body should be confirmed and renewed with the World Trade Organization; and (*c*) also noted that the name of the Centre would accordingly become International Trade Centre of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development/World Trade Organization.
